## G. Family Summer Reading Program Expenses:

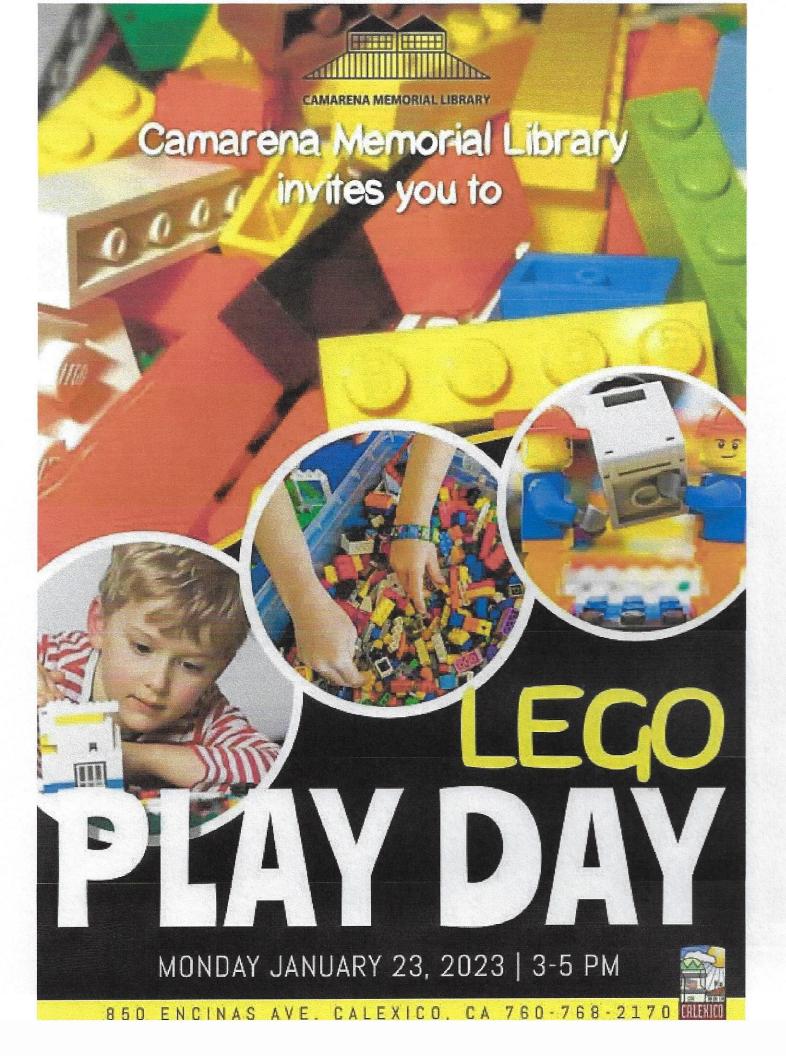

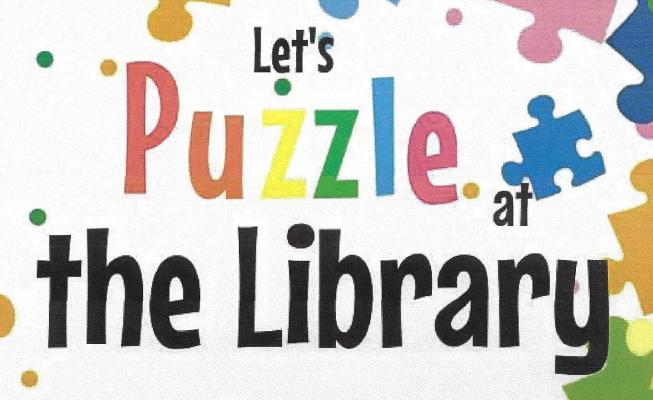
