### MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING BETWEEN FRIENDS OF THE CAMARENA MEMORIAL LIBRARY AND CAMARENA MEMORIAL LIBRARY

The following will constitute an operating agreement between the Friends of the Camarena Memorial Library (Friends) and the Camarena Memorial Library (Library). It will stand until and unless it is modified by mutual agreement of the Friends executive board and the Camarena Memorial Library administration. The Friends mission is to raise money and public awareness in the community to support the services and programs of the Library. As a non-profit, however, it is a distinct entity and is not a part of the Library.

The Library agrees to include the Friends in the long-term planning process to ensure that the Friends are aware of the goals and direction of the library.

The Library agrees to supply the Friends with a "Wishlist" each year that indicates the anticipated needs for Friends support.

The Library agrees to provide public space for Friends membership brochures and promotional materials.

The Library agrees to provide the Friends with staff support to assist them with development of the newsletter, mass mailing, meeting coordination, and Friends promotional materials.

**The Library** agrees to provide the Friends with space in the Library for book storage and sorting, book sales, and office needs.

The Friends agree to publicly support the Library and its policies.

**The Friends** agree that any and all monies raised will be spent exclusively for library programs, services and other Library defined needs unless otherwise agreed to by both the Friends and the Library.

**The Friends** agree that the library administration has the final say in accepting or declining any and all gifts made to the library.

The Friends agree to engage in advocacy efforts on behalf of the Library under the guidance of the Library and the Library's Board of Trustees.

The Friends agree that if they cease to actively fundraise and promote the Library, they will disband allowing for a new Friends group to be established in the future.





### ABOUT THE PROGRAM:

Adopt-A-Green Area is a program designed to promote community pride and involvement in maintaining and enhancing our facilities for all to enjoy. In coordination with Public Works Department, individuals, families, civic and business organizations can take an active role and a hands-on approach in various levels of maintenance of our green areas, parks and facilities. Sites approved for adoption as determined by the Parks, Recreation, Beautification, and Senior Services Commission.

#### PARTICIPANTS:

Can do the work with their volunteers, hire a contractor or provide financial sponsorship. Participants may include one of the following or in combination.

- o Individuals and Families (Must be at least 12 years of age)
- o Civil, Social, Sports, School or Non-Profit Organizations.
- o Businesses or Contractors.
- o Government Agencies

#### PARTICIPATION ACTIVITIES:

Performance of one or more of, but not limited to the following activities.

- o Removal of litter.
- o Planting or establishing, seedlings, trees, shrubs or flowers.
- o Graffiti abatement.
- Painting
- Watering
- Weed control

### PARTICIPANT'S COMMITMENT:

Carefully read and sign all of the necessary documentation.

- o Minimum requirement, to perform at least one (1) activity per month.
- o Contract term is for two (2) years, nontransferable and renewable at the end of each term if participant so desires.
- o Notify the Public Works Department seven (7) days prior to holding an activity.
- o At all times exercise safe working practices.

(Participant or the City of Calexico has the right to cancel or temporarily suspend the contract at any time if participant is unable to meet the minimum requirements or for any other due cause)

### **INSURANCE REQUIREMENTS:**

The City of Calexico <u>does not</u> provide insurance coverage for participants. Adoptees must provide the City with an annual Certificate of Liability Coverage naming the City as an Additional Insured in an amount of not less than \$1 million per event or activity.

### CITY'S COMMITMENT:

To provide assistance to the participants in this program to achieve the goals they have set through their activities.

- o Loan safety gear.
- o Provide plastic trash bags, collection and disposal.
- Assist in planting plans and techniques.
- o Safety orientation.
- o Replacement of recognition sign at the adopted site.

### SAFETY:

Is of the utmost importance and the number one concern. Safety measures are to be in place at all times.

- o Representative of participating groups must attend a safety orientation meeting.
- All participants and/or volunteers must sign a City of Calexico's Release, Hold Harmless and Agreement not to Sue form.
- Use common sense at all times.
- o Notify Public Works Department of any hazard you may have encountered.
- Avoid overexertion and drink plenty of fluids.

### KEY STEPS:

- Contact the Public Works Department at (760)768-2160 for adoption opportunities.
- o Complete application and submit it as soon as possible.
- o Provide an activity plan and schedule.
